Focusing In the top-left corner of the Photoshop window, you see the Photoshop icon (refer to Figure 3-1). This icon is one of the control tools available in the Window menu and is a good place to start. Clicking it starts the first window with a handy set of controls called Focus Gallery, as shown in Figure 3-2. FIGURE 3-2: You can start your image making by focusing on a specific area or selecting an object. You can take one of four actions: * **Double-click the Focus Gallery** The cursor changes to a magnifying glass and the Focus Gallery appears (see the left side of Figure 3-2). You can now focus on the top or bottom area of the image. * **Double-click an object in the image:** The cursor changes to a magnifying glass and any object you click is automatically focused (see the middle of Figure 3-2). You can then move the magnifying glass over another object or area of the image to zoom in on that portion, or you can move the focus back to the area that you previously selected. * **Click the background:** Clicking this button (which appears as a blue square with a border and a magnifying glass on it) highlights the entire canvas. The cursor appears at the edge of the canvas. When you click a specific area, you can easily edit it by dragging a selection box there. Check

Robert Ackley (footballer) Robert William Ackley (born 8 March 1939) is a former English footballer who played as a winger in the Football League for Cardiff City, Luton Town and Barrow. Playing career Ackley was born in Walthamstow, London. He joined Luton Town as an amateur in 1958, and signed as a professional in June 1959. He made his debut in the Football League First Division on 10 September 1960, in a 2–1 defeat to Birmingham City at St Andrew's. As a winger he was less successful than as a left-back, and he spent most of his time at Kenilworth Road on the sidelines. Ackley moved on to Cardiff City in 1961. He made his debut for them on 30 November 1961, in a 0–0 draw against Bradford City at Ninian Park. He moved to Barrow in 1964, and played there for one season.
