The code looks for the "To:" attribute within the email body. My question is how can I search for all emails that are delivered or that need to be delivered to a mailbox and in return, I want to get the name of the email account that the email is assigned to. The easiest way I can think of is to use a Windows batch script and search for emails that match the criteria for my results where I can then get the name of the email account. I'm thinking of using something like the following (where the dates indicate the criteria that the emails needs to match):
